What is abbreviation?

An abbreviation is a shortened form of a written word or phrase. Abbreviations may be used to save space and time, to avoid repetition of long words and phrases, or simply to conform to conventional usage.

What's the difference between an abbreviation and acronym?

Some people are unsure whether to call **ASAP** or **APPT** ABBREVIATION OR ACRONYM. BOTH ABBREVIATION AND ACRONYM ARE USED TO REFER TO SHORTENED FORM, BUT ACRONYM IS A SHORTENED FORM OF A PHRASE AND IS USUALLY MADE UP OF INITIAL LETTERS OF THAT PHRASE. FOR EXAMPLE, **NATO** (North Atlantic Treaty Organization), and **ASAP** comes from (as soon as possible) abbreviation, on the other hand can be shortened forms of words phrases, and need not necessarily be made up of initial letters of either.
